

How to: Shrimp & Lemons

- 1. Trace line drawing onto watercolor paper.
- 2. <u>Lemons</u>: Paint lemons yellow and leave <u>WHITE</u> areas. Let dry. Mix medium orange *Q* yellow and darken lemon rind.
- 3. <u>Shrimp</u>: paint shrimp in with medium orange. Let dry. Mix purple and a little black together and outline the shrimps.
- 4. Using the same mixture, paint in you foreground and background. Use more water for background to create a wash.
- 5. <u>Parsley</u>: Mix green & orange and paint in parsley. Let dry. Add a little black to the paint mixture and outline and paint other areas of the parsley you want darker.
- 6. <u>Shrimp</u>: Mix brown I orange. Paint in dark areas of shrimp: the tail, the creases of the shrimps body, the head.
- 7. <u>Shrimp Eyes</u>: Paint in shrimp eyes with black. ***<u>MAKE SURE</u> to leave a white area in the shape of a crescent moon on the eyes.
