



How to: Spring Egg

1. Trace line drawing onto watercolor paper.
2. Paint in small “yellow” flowers first and the center eye of larger flowers. **Instead of the bright yellow paint I used the light orange. Next mix light and medium orange and paint in darker orange flowers.
3. Pinkish petals and flowers. Mix red with light orange to create a blush color. Paint in flowers large petals and small flowers.
4. Darker pink flowers: Mix red and dark purple. Paint in dark pink large flowers and smaller flowers.
4. Lavender flowers: Next mix red and purple to create lavender. Paint in lavender flower. Then add a small amount of black and paint in smaller flowers.
5. Blue flowers: I used the light blue from the tray and painted in flowers.
6. Leaves and vines: Mix two shades of olive green. For lighter green mixture, mix green and light orange. For a darker olive green mix green and brown. Paint with lighter green mixture first. Let dry. Use the darker olive green to paint in detail work and darker areas of the vines and leaves.
7. Outline egg: I chose the olive green shade to outline my egg. You can use any color you wish for the outline.
